Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act in a case arising out of FIR No.130 dated 17.07.2013, registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

As per the allegations in the FIR the complainant is of 18 years and was alone at home on 16.07.2013 at about 7.00 p.m. The petitioner along with co-accused came in their house and started beating to him. As per the allegations in the FIR no injury has been attributed to the present petitioner. The petitioner was arrested on 18.07.2013 and he was granted interim bail. Thereafter he was declared proclaimed offender on 08.08.2014. He surrendered on 06.11.2014 and a supplementary challan was presented against him on 29.01.2015. Out of 16 prosecution witnesses none has been

examined so far. All the co-accused are on bail.

Keeping in view the above facts and the trial is not likely to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot.
