RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 971 dated 16.11.2013, under Sections 387/506/420/467/468/471/120-B/216 IPC, registered at Police Station, City Rohtak.

The FIR was registered on the basis of complaint made by Achin Jain-complainant, alleging that on 16.11.2013, he received a telephonic call from mobile number 08570855978 asking him to pay a sum of Rs.1 crore as ransom. He was also threatened to face dire consequences. On a subsequent telephone call, the caller told him that he was Dogga and had absconded from the police custody.

Learned State counsel, on instructions ASI Narinder Singh, has informed the Court that out of 13 prosecution witnesses, 7 have been examined and the petitioner had facilitated aforesaid Dogga in escaping from PGIMS, Rohtak. He is also facing trial in FIR No.429 dated 09.10.2013, under Sections 223, 224 IPC, registered at Police Station Urban Estate, Rohtak.

Since the trial is at the final state, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.
