Petitioner is a complainant in a case of assault registered vide FIR No. 202 dated 23.08.2014 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 and 27 of the Arms Act registered against respondents No. 6 to 11. A cross version has also been recorded in the said case vide rapat No. 25 dated 23.08.2014. The petitioner claims that the investigation has not been conducted in a fair manner and that no action is being taken against respondents No. 6 to 11, who are openly roaming in the village.

Reply has been filed on behalf of State and it has been stated that impartial investigation is being conducted. The police claims that the house of the private respondents have been raided to arrest them after obtaining their arrest warrants.

After considering the facts and circumstances of this case, without expressing any opinion regarding the attribution against the official respondents being partial, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case petitioner submits a representation to the SSP, Bathinda expressing his grievance, he would look into the matter to see that the investigation is

conducted fairly. Such representation can be filed within a period of 15 days and it is expected that the same would be taken into consideration within a period of next two months. However, it is specifically mentioned that in case any of the accused is required to be arrested; specific reasons would be mentioned by investigating agency bringing it to the notice of the SSP, Bathinda.
