The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, namely, Manoj in case FIR No.69 dated 10.03.2015 registered under Sections 147/148/149/323/364/365/367 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani during the pendency of the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the name of the petitioner was not mentioned in the FIR and he has falsely been

implicated in the case whereas no offence is made out under Section 364 IPC. Learned counsel also submits that all the injuries are simple in nature and nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that out of ten accused, four have been granted bail under Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. and other three co-accused, namely, Sachin, Sandeep @ Nambardar and Sunil Kumar @ Sonu have already been released on regular bail by this Court vide orders dated 14.09.2015 and 05.10.2015 passed in **Criminal Misc. No.M-29873 of 2015** and **Criminal Misc. No.M-32734 of 2015** respectively and the petitioner is in custody since 13.03.2015.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has not disputed the custody period as well as the factum of granting regular bail to co-accused, namely, Sachin, Sandeep @ Nambardar and Sunil Kumar @ Sonu.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the fact that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Sachin, Sandeep @ Nambardar and Sunil Kumar @ Sonu have been released on regular bail by this Court and the petitioner is in custody since 13.03.2015, no purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Manoj is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
