Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.' for short), seek direction to the official respondents not to harass and humiliate the petitioners.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply by way of affidavit dated 11.05.2015 filed in the Court today, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Nishan Singh, Police Station City, Jagraon and ASI Dharam Pal, Police Station City, Barnala, submits that it is only petitioner No.2 namely Vishal Garg @ Vishal Gupta son of Satparkash who is facing trial in three FIRs in district Barnala and one FIR in District Jagraon. So far as the other districts in the State of Punjab are concerned, she has not got the latest information and the same shall be provided to the petitioner. As far as other petitioners No.1, 3 & 4 are concerned, learned counsel for the State submits that they are not wanted in

any case so far. She further submits that no further orders are called for, in the present case and the present petition may be disposed of, as such.

Having heard the learned counsel for the State and after careful perusal of the record of the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that in view of the reply by way of affidavit filed and coupled with the statement made by learned counsel for the State, present petition does not survive any further and the same is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

However, it is made clear that as and when the investigating agency, in any of the FIRs, wants to enquire something from the petitioners No.1, 3 & 4 as well, they shall be issued due notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. and will not be put any harassment by the investigating agency.

So far as the total number of FIRs allegedly pending against petitioner No.2 namely Vishal Garg @ Vishal Gupta are concerned, particulars thereof, shall be supplied to him by the office of Director General of Police, Punjab-respondent No.2, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
