MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for release of the petitioner on bail in terms thereof in case FIR No.164 dated 24.11.2014 under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

The petitioner had contended that he had solemnized the marriage with the daughter of the complainant which has now been accepted by the complainant and he has no objection to it any more.

Noticing the above fact this court had granted interim protection to the petitioner vide its order dated 2.2.2015 but

subject to the condition that the petitioner complies with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is not disputed by the learned counsel appearing for the State on instructions from HC Hans Raj that the petitioner has since joined the investigation.

Noticing this fact as also the peculiar facts of the petitioner's marriage with the daughter of the complainant without parental consent leading to disgruntlement and the FIR as a consequence thereto, I would deem it appropriate to accept this petition and hereby make the interim directions dated 2.2.2015 absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
