Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.102 dated 07.07.2015, under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 13.10.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that now the parties have amicably settled their dispute.

Notice of motion for 17.12.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be admitted to interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Gurmail Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
