Petitioner, by way of instant application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.' for short), seeks his transfer from District Jail, Yamuna Nagar to District Jail, Sirsa or to Central Jail-II, Hisar.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply by way of affidavit dated 11.05.2015 filed in the Court today, is taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner has shown a communication bearing No.1924 dated 01.04.2015 from Superintendent, District Jail, Sirsa to Director General (Prisons), Haryana to the effect that if the petitioner is transferred back from the District Jail, Yamuna Nagar to District Jail, Sirsa, then there would be no objection by the Superintendent, District Jail, Sirsa.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let Director General (Prisons), Haryana-respondent No.2 consider the request of the petitioner for transfer from District Jail Yamuna Nagar to District Jail, Sirsa in view of the communication dated 01.04.2015, issued by Superintendent, District Jail, Sirsa, within a reasonable time.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the State submits that the appropriate order shall be passed within a period of one month from today.

In view of the abovesaid respective stands taken by learned counsel for the parties, present petition is disposed of, with a direction to Director General (Prisons), Haryana-respondent No.2 to consider the request of the petitioner, for his transfer from District Jail, Yamuna Nagar to District Jail, Sirsa in view of the abovesaid official communication bearing No.1924 dated 01.04.2015, written to him by the Superintendent, District Jail, Sirsa, by passing an appropriate order at an early date, strictly in accordance with law but in any case, within a period of four weeks from today.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
