The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 for quashing of the FIR No. 68 dated 2.9.2014, under Sections 382,323,148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station, Bhadaur, District Barnala alongwith all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 9.10.2014 (Annexure P-2).

In pursuant to the order dated 16.10.2014 passed by this Court, report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala, recieved.

He has reported that statements of the complainant as well as the

accused have been recorded. It has been reported to this Court that a compromise is effected between the parties and the same is voluntary and without any coercion.

A perusal of FIR shows that it was a dispute between the complainant and the Truck Union. Complainant was beaten and he was kidnapped.

Since, the matter has amicably settled between the parties, therefore, the FIR in question alongwith consequential proceedings stands quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
