This is a petition for quashing of FIR, inter alia, on the ground that the offence alleged is non-cognizable and that offence under Section 420 IPC which has been added with a non-cognizable offence is not made out from the bare reading of the FIR.

On asking of the Court, counsel for the petitioner informs that the prosecution agency on the basis of the investigation has till date formed no opinion to present challan.

In view of said circumstances, this petition is disposed of as premature, at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again in case the challan is presented in non-cognizable offence.
