Mr. Kler, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh confirms the aforesaid position and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required in further investigation of the case.

Since the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency, interim order dated 06.02.2015 is made absolute.
