This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to depute a senior police official to enquire/investigate the representation dated 01.10.2015 (Annexure P-3) qua false implication of her husband Ajay Kumar in case FIR No.174 dated 30.09.2015 registered under Sections 307/323/295-A/120-B/148/149/506 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel states that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied, in case directions are issued to respondent No.2 to consider the representation (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner and investigate with regard to false implication of her husband in the present FIR.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to decide the representation (Annexure P-3), after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, by passing a speaking order, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
