Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.191 dated 15.11.2014, under Sections 420 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Civil Lines, District Bathinda **(Annexure P-1)**.

As per the allegations, the petitioner/accused along with his co-accused were employees of M/s Jeevanjod Adhesive Company. The complainant is dealer of the Company. Both the aforesaid accused employees are alleged to have misused the provisions of a scheme and thereby gave the complainant less discount and thereby caused loss to the tune of Rs.5 lacs to the dealer. Petitioner is also alleged to have accompanied the co-accused Abhishek Sharma while he lifted a diary containing transactions of the dealer with his customers.

It is submitted that co-accused Abhishek Sharma charged with similar allegations has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 6.10.2015.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that after the grant of interim protection by this Court, while issuing notice of motion on 14.10.2015, the petitioner/accused has since joined the investigations.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Raghubir Singh, concedes that in terms of the order dated 14.10.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 14.10.2015, is made absolute.
