Petitioners, by way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seek quashing of FIR No.206 dated 14.11.2009 registered under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Gurminder Singh, City Kotkapura, submits that since the cancellation report has been prepared and the same shall be presented to the learned court of competent jurisdiction without any further loss of time, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of, as such.
