AJAY TEWARI, J.(Oral)

The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.233 dated 01.09.2006 registered under Sections 18, 61 & 85 of the N.D.P.S. Act at Police Station Lambi, District Muktsar Sahib.

Short affidavit as well as custody certificate filed on behalf of Mohinder Singh, Head Warder, Superintendent, Sub Jail Sri Mukatsar Sahib in compliance of order dated 19.02.2015 is taken on record. Copies have been supplied. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone almost 3 months and the recovery was 50 gms of opium.

Learned Additional Advocate General has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the C.J.M/Duty Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.

As regards affidavit filed by the Superintendent, Sub Jail, Sri Muktsar Sahib in compliance of order dated 19.02.2015, it has been mentioned that the custody certificate could not be sent due to the negligence of an employee namely Baljinder Singh and he has been suspended and further action will be taken against him accordingly.

The explanation is accepted. The matter is adjourned to 24.08.2015 to enable the State to file status report with regard to the action taken against the defalcating employee.
