LISA GILL, J.

Petitioner prays for the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.246 dated 21.09.2014 under Sections 447, 427, 379, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

It is submitted that the dispute pertained to a passage which was subject matter of a civil suit filed at earlier point of time by the petitioner against the complainant.

During the pendency of this petition, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties on 19.11.2014.

Learned counsel for the State had sought time to verify the factum of the settlement. It is stated on instructions from Head Constable Ashok Kumar that the parties have resolved the matter amicably. Furthermore, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the above, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition.

Consequently, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. He shall join investigation as and when required. He shall abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
