The instant petition has been filed for quashing FIR No.52 dated 23.5.2013 under Sections 363, 366 IPC, Police Station Julkan, District Patiala and the subsequent proceedings.

The investigation is still not complete. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh submits that even proclamation for appearance of the petitioner has since been issued.

I find no ground for indulgence in exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to seek appropriate remedy after the investigation is complete.
