JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 235, dated 01.09.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 353, 186, 333, 307, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

As per the allegations, the petitioner alongwith her family members had thrown brick-bats at the police party thwarting their effort to search their house for recovery of poppy husk.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the role attributed to the petitioner-Nirmal Kaur is that she caught hold of Head Constable Bhola Singh and torn his uniform. It is contended that a false case has been foisted against the petitioner. It is further contended that the petitioner is eighteen years' old girl student of 10+2 class and is in custody since 02.09.2015 and the investigation qua her are over.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, does not refute the custody period of the petitioner and as also, the investigation qua her are over.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts of the case as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused-Nirmal Kaur deserves the concession of regular bail and as such she is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sangur.
