Perusal of the record shows that petitioners have approached this Court, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the impugned complaint and the summoning order, however, without availing their equally efficacious alternative remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order.

In view of the above, petitioners are relegated to their equally efficacious alternative remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order, at the first instance, however, with liberty to the petitioners to approach this Court again by way of a similar quashing petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., if necessity arises.

It is also made clear that if petitioners would file an appropriate revision petition against the impugned summoning order within a period of one month from today, respondents shall not raise the issue of limitation against the petitioners.

Disposed of, accordingly.
