FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 04.11.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Nabha has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Hardeep Singh and Nachhatar Kaur as well as of complainant Mandeep Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a case of simple injury and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.42 dated 10.06.2015 under Sections 325,323,34 IPC, Police Station, Bhadson, Tehsil Nabha and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
