Though, the parties had earlier settled their dispute before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court by way of settlement arrived at dated 10.04.2015, however, inspite of the same certain differences have cropped up and after intervention by this Court and impressing upon both the sides it has been agreed that settlement agreement dated 10.04.2015 will be modified to the extent that the mother Manjit Kaur as has been aggrieved upon will keep visiting rights to meet child Jaspreet Kaur on 1st and 3rd Sunday of every month of English calender for two and a half hours and the petitioner Hari Singh or his wife Mohinder Kaur as is convenient to them would bring the child to Gurdwara Dukh Niwaran Sahib, Patiala as per the time settle between them on telephone one day prior to the meeting and Manjit Kaur will meet the child independently and interact with her within the premises of Gurdwara and shall not allow anyone except her father Shamsher Singh to be present if so desired.

In view of which parties have agreed to abide by these obligations and rest of the terms and conditions of previous settlement dated 10.04.2015 shall remain the same.

Exercising power under Section 482 Cr.P.C. and in view of settlement and that the complainant Manjit Kaur agrees that she has no objection if FIR No.94 dated 29.05.2010 under Sections 406, 498A,323,506,34 IPC registered at Police Station, Ambala Sadar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners. The parties shall be borne by their statement made before this Court as well as settlement dated 10.4.2015. Parties are also undertaken that they will not file any civil or criminal case against each other arising out of their relationship and property in pursuance of the marriage of complainant with deceased son Harvinder Singh of the petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
