Petitioner through the instant petition under Section 482 CrPC seeks a direction to the Director General of Police, Punjab to restrain respondent No.3 Deputy Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Hoshiarpur from harassing and pressurising the petitioners, claiming that the petitioners have solemnised the marriage of their daughter Priyanka to one Satish Kumar on 19.03.2014. Priyanka returned to her parental house on 02.04.2014 but on 03.04.2014 when she had gone to Hoshiarpur for shopping, she did not return.

Petitioner No.2 had filed habeas corpus petition as Priyanka was found residing with one Kulwinder Singh. The writ petition was disposed of on the statement of Priyanka. Grievance of the petitioners is that they had been called to the office of Deputy Superintendent

of Police Headquarters respondent No.3 on various dates.

On instructions of Head Constable Manjit Singh it has been informed that the petitioners are not required for any inquiry or investigation by the police at this stage.

Taking into consideration the above said circumstances, this petition is disposed of with the direction that in case the petitioners are required by the police for any investigation in any particular case notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. in writing will be sent to them indicating the day, date and time for appearance before any police authority. This order will remain operative for a period of one year and only in the circumstances mentioned herein above.
