Report dated 06.11.2015 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Ankush Jindal, Aman Jindal, Kewal Krishan and Sushil Jindal as well as of complainant Neha Jindal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure and today counsel for the petitioner has handed over a demand draft No.583578 dated 14.10.2015 amounting ₹2,50,000/- which has been received on behalf of the complainant by her counsel.

Keeping in view that it is a pure matrimonial dispute and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in

Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal

543 and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.120 dated 11.09.2011 under Sections 406,498-A IPC, Police Station, City South Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
