Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C is for quashing of FIR No.64 dated 01.08.2010 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149, 506, 452 of the IPC at Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the parties.

This Court vide order dated 16.10.2014, directed the parties to appear before the trial Court on the date fixed and trial Court was directed to record its satisfaction with regard to genuineness of the compromise in question.

In pursuance to the order passed by this Court, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, recorded the statements of both the parties, wherein parties asserted that the compromise has been effected voluntarily and without any threat, undue influence and coercion of any type. After recording the statements, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar also submitted the report regarding his satisfactions with regard to authenticity of compromise and the same having been done voluntarily by the parties.

Since both the parties have amicably resolved their differences by entering into amicable settlement and the same will serve as everlasting tool between the parties in order to maintain peace and public tranquility.

Resultantly, FIR No.64 dated 01.08.2010 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149, 506, 452 of the IPC at Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), along with entire subsequent proceedings, if any, undertaken stand quashed.
