Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.151 dated 30.11.2014 under Sections 148,149,332,353,352 IPC, and Section 3(2) of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act,1984, PS Rojka Meo,Distt.Mewat.

As per allegations in the FIR lodged by police authorities a group of villages including the present petitioner had blocked the traffic and attacked the police party and damaged police vehicle in which incident the police officials are also alleged to have received injuries. The agitating villagers were demanding registration of a case of murder against owner of a company on account of death of a villager.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of offence which

amounts to challenging the authority of the State, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
