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MAHESH GROVER, J.

In this petition of 2012 on 22.4.2013 notice of motion was issued to respondents No.2 to 9 for 16.7.2013, on which date, as per office report, notices issues to respondents No.2, 6 and 7 were received back unserved with the report that respondent No.2 is residing in Canada and respondents No.6 and 7 are not residing at the given address. Notices issued to respondents No.3 to 5, 8 and 9 were not received back served or otherwise. It was ordered that correct address of respondents No.2, 6 and 7 be furnished within one week from that day and fresh notices were ordered to be issued to the unserved respondents for 10.9.2013. Thereafter the case was adjourned to

2.12.2013 and then to 9.4.2014 when notices to unserved respondents were ordered to be issued for 29.7.2014. The case was taken up on 30.7.2014 and it was ordered to be shown in the urgent cause list on 6.8.2014, on which date learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the unserved respondents can be served through their counsel appearing before the trial Court. Accordingly, dasti service upon respondents No.3 to 5 was ordered to be effected for 10.10.2014 through their counsel appearing before the trial Court. On 10.10.2014 it was reported by the office that the counsel appearing before the trial court on behalf of respondents No.3 to 5 stated that he has no instructions on their behalf and then notices to the said respondents were ordered to be issued for 12.1.2015. On 12.1.2015 fresh dasti notices were ordered to be issued to the said respondents for 3.3.2015 on furnishing correct addresses. On 3.3.2015 last opportunity was granted to the petitioner to effect service upon the unserved respondents for 9.7.2015. Today Dasti notices have not been received served or otherwise.

In view of the above, it is clear that the petitioner is not interested in prosecuting the instant petition.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
