Petitioners seeks quashing of FIR No.185 dated 05.07.2014 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar City, Amritsar at the instance of respondent No.2 Rimpny on the allegation that she was married to petitioner No.1 and was maltreated, tortured and given beatings on the pretext of bringing inadequate dowry.

The matter has been compromised. Parties to the marriage have decided to part company on payment of lump sum alimony.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court and make statements regarding the compromise having arrived

at between the parties. Report has been received from the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily, without any threat, coercion or pressure.

In view of the matrimonial dispute having been resolved amicably, following the judgments in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal), 1052** and **B.S. Joshi and others Vs. State of Haryana and another, 2003 (2) RCR (Criminal) 888,** this petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that the terms of the compromise would be complied with by the parties. In case of violation of any condition, it will be open to the complainant or the prosecution agency to approach this Court for revival of the proceedings.
