AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.70 dated 14.09.2015 registered under Section 406 IPC at Police Station City-II, Mansa, District Mansa.

Today the learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Kaur states that the petitioner is no more required for custodial interrogation but she may be directed to join investigation.

In these circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, she shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 08.12.2015 and on any other date as and when her presence is required. In case the petitioner does not appear before the investigating officer in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
