JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Ravi Khanna in case FIR No.145 dated 10.09.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 452, 324, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code (now Section 307 IPC deleted and Section 326 IPC added) registered with Police Station Division No.8, Jalandhar.

The occurrence on 10.09.2014 took place in the office premises between neighbors who are transporters. There is a version and cross version as there are injuries on both sides under Section 326 IPC.

As per allegations petitioner has been attributed a *Kirpan* blow on the head of complainant Paramjit Singh Bal which has been opined to be grievous in nature. It is contended that petitioner also suffered injuries by

sharp edged weapon which have been opined to be grievous in nature. Further submits that complainant party was the aggressor and have been granted anticipatory bail in the cross version.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 19th of October, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
