By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.488, dated 23.12.2014, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners states the compromise has been entered between the parties. The matter stands settled. A petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., bearing No. CRM-M-35900 of 2015 for quashing the proceedings on the basis of compromise has also been filed. In pursuance of the order dated 15.10.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned counsel for the complainant admits the factum of compromise and states that he has no objection in case the present petition is allowed.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 15.10.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
