This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and further to ensure that they may not be harassed by respondents No. 4 to 7.

On instructions from HC Gurmail Singh, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner had given statements before Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazlika that they do not require further protection. Their parents have also given statement before the concerned authority giving consent to the marriage, therefore the instant petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having become infructuous.
