Prayer in this petition is to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.6 to 9 by issuing necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3.

This Court while issuing notice of motion on 02.02.2015 has noted the contention of learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners No.1 and 2 have solemnized marriage on 30.1.2015 against the wishes of their parents and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali was directed to assess the threat perception attributed to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head-constable-Kashmiri Lal has placed on record the statements of petitioner No.1, Priyanka Kumari and petitioner No.2 Kishan Kumar wherein they have stated that they have no danger from anybody and they do not not require any security as well.

In view of the statement furnished by the State counsel, no action in the present petition is called for and is dismissed as such.
