INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.300 dated 17.12.2013, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short' the Act')

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, this Court finds that 160 kgs poppy husk was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. This recovery falls in commercial quantity. Section 37 of the Act bars to grant the bail to the person in case of commercial quantity.

Therefore, finding no merit in the instant petition, the same is dismissed. As the petitioner is in custody since 17.09.2014, therefore, the learned trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments and if requires, adjourning the case on day to day basis and dispose of it preferably within four months.
