Instant petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 50 dated 19.03.2010 under Section 307, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Raikot, Ludhiana and all other subsequent proceedings arising out of the said FIR on the basis of compromise dated 06.10.2014 (Annexure P-3).

2. Report of learned trial Court has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise has been effected between the parties without any pressure or coercion in any manner. The same is genuine one. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as *Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another (2014) 6 SCC 466* I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4.. Consequently, instant petition is allowed and FIR No. 50 dated 19.03.2010 under Section 307, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Raikot, Ludhiana and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua petitioners.
