Respondent No.2 Jyoti is present in the Court to inform that no compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

On the instructions from HC Krishan Baldev, it has been informed that on completion of investigation the report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C is ready to be presented in the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Singh the matter has not been compromised, this petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of alleged compromise is dismissed with a cost of Rs. 20,000/- which can be recovered from the petitioners by the complainant wife.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to file afresh after the matter is compromised.

The permission as prayed is granted subject to the condition that petitioners will pay the cost amount of Rs.20,000/- to the complainant within a period of two months in the shape of bank draft in the name of the complainant to be handed over to her before the Illaqa Magistrate, before filing any such petition.
