AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.55 dated 01.02.2015 registered under Sections 186, 353, 379, 188, 307 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the allegation is of illegal mining against the petitioner and he has now been in custody since 20.08.2015 and that the co-accused has already been granted bail.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Ram Parkash has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Palwal.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
