1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel states that inadvertently in the memo of parties and in the representation (Annexure P-4) the name of respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh has been mentioned as Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh and prays that the same may be corrected.

Allowed as prayed for.

Registry is directed to make necessary corrections in the memo of parties as well as in the representation (Annexure P-4).

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of

respondent Nos.4 and 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Affidavit (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 12.05.1995 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Voter Identity Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 11.06.1991. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh (Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
