Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks appropriate directions to the official respondents to provide protection to life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents against whom petitioner has got the FIR registered.

Notice of motion was issued.

After hearing learned counsel for the State as well as learned counsel for the private respondents, instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib-respondent No.2 to look into the matter, consider the threat perception raised by the petitioner and take appropriate action, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib-respondent No.2 is also directed to ensure that no harm is caused to life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents or by anybody else on their behalf.

Disposed of, accordingly.
