Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 144, dated 15.09.2013, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

While issuing notice of motion on 27.10.2014, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, directed that in the even of arrest, petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer in connection with abovesaid case FIR.

On instructions from ASI Devinder Singh, learned State

counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for interrogation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 27.10.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to comply with the terms of the compromise. In case, he fails, the aggrieved persons will be at liberty to move appropriate application.

Petition disposed of accordingly.
