This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against her vide FIR No.173 dated 21.06.2014 under Sections 498-A, 304-B and 34 IPC, at Police Station Shivaji Colony, Rohtak.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Samunder Singh submits that out of 14 witnesses cited by the prosecution 06 have been examined and trial court has fixed three consecutive dates i.e. 15th, 16th and 17th December, 2015 for further prosecution evidence. He further states that prosecution shall not delay the matter and shall endeavour to examine the witnesses at the earliest.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition at this stage.
