This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of application/complaint (Annexure P-11), summoning order dated 21.02.2015 (Annexure P-12) and the order of non-bailable warrants dated 23.09.2015 (Annexure P-13).

The learned counsel contends that the complaint (Annexure P-11) has been filed as a counter blast to save the respondent's husband, son and son-in-law and herself in criminal cases registered against them for misbehaving and for giving brutal beatings to the petitioner as the petitioner had registered the case of theft of electricity against the respondent. He submits that when the petitioner along with other officials

checking the electricity meter of adjoining house of the respondent, they found that the theft of electricity was going on in the house of respondent. Thereafter, the petitioner went to the house of the respondent for checking her electricity bills and they closed the door instead of showing the electricity bills. The petitioner made a video recording of the theft of electricity from his official mobile phone and then again the petitioner along with other officials proceeded the checking process of electricity bills of the respondent and after watching the video recording of theft, the family members of the respondent gave brutal beatings to the petitioner and the petitioner filed an FIR against them.

Heard.

Keeping in view the nature, gravity of the offence and the fact that the petitioner had forcibly entered into the house of the respondent without her permission as she was alone at that time, for checking the electricity load of her house and outrage her modesty which is supported by the testimonies of CW2 and CW3, this petition is dismissed.
