LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for anticipatory bail in FIR No. 91 dated 23.08.2014 registered under Sections 148, 452, 324, 323, 506, 427, 149 IPC (Sections 326, 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

It is contended that the petitioner is attributed with an injury on the elbow of right arm of Rashpinder Singh. This injury has been found to be simple in nature. The petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to order dated 31.10.2014.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable Kaushal Chander, affirms and verifies that the petitioner has indeed joined investigation. Recovery has been effected from him. Nature of the injury attributed by the petitioner to Rashpinder Singh is simple. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

The trial of the case is likely to take some time to conclude. Keeping in view the facts narrated above, no useful

purpose shall be solved by taking the petitioner into custody at this stage.

In view of abovesaid facts and circumstances, order dated 31.10.2014 is made absolute without commenting on the merits of the case.

Present petition is, accordingly, allowed.
