By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a complaint case bearing No. 22 dated 22.02.2013, pending in the Court of JMIC, Narnaul.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the dispute is essentially of a civil nature. The respondent No.2/complainant filed a civil suit which was dismissed, vide order dated 16.01.2010 (Annexure P-14). The appeal preferred by the respondent No.2 was also dismissed, vide judgment dated 10.01.2013 (Annexure P-15). The petitioner is not involved in any

other case except one, in which, the cancellation report has already been filed.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel has acknowledged the factum of filing the cancellation report.

Heard.

The petitioner is directed to appear/surrender before the trial Court, within a week from today and furnish fresh bail bonds/surety bonds. In the event of his doing so, he shall be admitted to bail by the releasing Court during the pendency of trial, to its satisfaction.
