After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw this petition, however, submits that observation with regard to time i.e. 5.00 p.m. made in the order dated 22.02.2013 by learned JMJC, Mohindergarh, is without any basis and will affect entire case of the petitioner.
