Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of directions issued by this Court on 16.10.2015, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel has affirmed the factum of joining the investigation on instructions from ASI-Rachhpal Singh.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that two accused have left India despite the directions issued by this Court and petitioner No.1 is also in process of leaving India and a complaint in this regard has also been made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, concerned.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and they have been released on interim bail, however, keeping in view the apprehension of learned counsel for the complainant and also the fact that two accused have left India, petitioners are directed to hand-

over their passports to the Investigating Officer, if any.

Accordingly, interim directions issued by this Court on 16.10.2015 is made absolute subject to deposition of their passport, if any.

The petition stands disposed of.
