Learned counsel for the respondents No.2 to 6 has appeared and stated that the matter has been compromised.

The investigating officer present in the Court has got no intimation regarding the compromise.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction that the supplementary statements of the complainant and victims, who are impleaded as respondents No.2 to 6, would be recorded by the investigating officer.

On the basis of statements, if the investigating agency is satisfied that the circumstances warrant filing of the

cancellation report or untraced report, the same would be submitted. It will be appreciated in case the supplementary statements of the respondents are recorded within a period of one month.

The investigating agency on the basis of supplementary statements may file cancellation/untraced report before the Illaqa Magistrate. It will be open to the complainant/affected parties thereafter to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate and get their statements recorded regarding no objection to the acceptance of cancellation/untraced report.
