The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.36 dated 26.07.2014, under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, P.S. Dorangla, District Gurdaspur.

On 27.10.2014 this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is ready to pay the amount to the complainant. He seeks time to file an application for impleading the complainant as a party to the present petition.

Adjourned to 10.11.2014.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 sub Section 2 Clause (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Thereafter after due deliberation, petitioner and respondent No.2 have reached to some concurrence, that a total amount of Rs.50,000/- should be paid by the petitioner to respondent No.2.

Mr. Baath, learned counsel for the petitioner has brought two demand draft Nos.853717 and 853718 in the sum of Rs.20,000/- and 30,000/- respectively.

The aforesaid demand drafts have been handed over to the complainant who is present in Court in the present of his counsel. Photocopies of the same are retained on record.

In view of above, order dated 27.10.2014 is made absolute.

Petitions stands disposed of.
