Prayer in the petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.237 dated 16.11.2014, under Sections 411, 414, 489-A, 489-C and 489-D of IPC, under Sections 15, 18, 21 and 22 of the NDPS Act, under Section 25 of the Arms Act and under Sections 14-F and 3-34-20 of I.P. Act, registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

Vide order dated 7.1.2015, this Court has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to compliance of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh states that pursuant to the order dated 7.1.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 7.1.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
