Quashing of the FIR No.19 dated 05.05.2014 under Sections 452, 336, 506, 34 IPC and 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms RMS Act, registered at Police Station Qadian District Batala (Annexure P-1) and its consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2), is being sought.

FIR was registered by respondent No.2-Mohinder Singh with the allegations that on 05.05.2014 at about 03:30 PM, he reached his home. The son-in-law of his brother namely Sarwan Singh son of Kartar Singh, along with him Tar, who is the aunt's son of Sarwan Singh and one unknown person along with them came in their motorcycle Pulsar, Colour Balck and they parked their motorcycle in the lane and came enter in his house and started abusing him and also extended threat to his life and

while going Sarwan Singh fired two shots in air.

The matter has been amicably resolved by the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 17.10.2014, status report has been received by the District & Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur. Statements of the parties have been recorded to the effect that a compromise has been affected without pressure, coercion or undue influence between the parties and respondent No.2-Mohinder Singh has no objection if the present FIR is quashed.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.19 dated 05.05.2014 under Sections 452, 336, 506, 34 IPC and 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms RMS Act, registered at Police Station Qadian District Batala (Annexure P-1), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of qua petitioners.
