Prayer in this petition is for quashing of order dated 18.09.2014 passed by respondent No.2 as well as Kalandra dated 30.08.2014 vide which proceedings under Sections 145/146 Cr.P.C. have been initiated.

Learned counsel for respondents No.4, Roshan Lal son of Surta Ram and respondent No.5, Tejinder son of Jiya Lal, both residents of village Mujafat Bagh Singh, Tehsil Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar have submitted their respective affidavits. The contents of affidavit as submitted by respondent No.4 reads as under; and similar affidavit has been filed by respondent No.5

“1. That the deponent is permanent resident of above

2. *That a dispute has arisen between the parties and now a compromise has been effected between the parties by compromise dated 28.10.2014 which is already on record of Hon'ble Court as Annexure P-8.*
3. *That the terms and conditions of compromise has been complied with and deponent has no grievance if the above CRM-M-35937 of 2014 be allowed on the basis of compromise dated 28.10.2014 in which deponent is arrayed as respondent No.4.*

In view of the affidavits submitted by respondents No.4 and 5, the order dated 18.09.2014 passed by respondent No.2 as well as Kalandra dated 30.08.2014 whereby proceedings under Sections 145/146 Cr.P.C. were initiated, become redundant.

No further proceedings are called for.

Petition is disposed of.
